



Arclin Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Arclin is committed to being a responsible corporate citizen. As part of that commitment, Arclin seeks to source products, components and materials from companies that share our values. Arclin is in compliance with the rules implementing Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act - "Conflict Minerals Rule" - adopted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission regarding disclosure of conflict minerals sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo and surrounding areas in order to promote ethical sourcing.

Arclin has adopted a Supplier Code of Conduct requiring suppliers to disclose if they are providing Arclin with any "3TG" metals (tin, tantalum, tungsten or gold) that were sourced from the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Congo Republic, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda or Zambia. At this time, we can confirm that we do not purchase or use any Conflict Minerals.
